



Fundraising Agreement

Ten Thousand Books values diversity in our communities and in our books. It is our goal to add books with diverse voices and experiences to school classrooms across Minnesota and beyond.

You or your organization has expressed interest in creating a fundraiser for your school with Ten Thousand Books. It is our belief that children of all races, ethnicities, religions, identities, and abilities should have the opportunity for their school to receive these curated books. In order to accomplish this goal, we have created a Sister School pairing program. Individual fundraisers will have the opportunity to support a school of their choice while also supporting a Sister School. By supporting a Sister School, you will be creating an avenue for positive change in two communities.

Ten Thousand Books is focused on building connections across communities. We are excited to partner with you. Thank you for taking this action for social change.

We have outlined the policies of the Fundraising Agreement below.

- 1) One must establish a Sister School pairing and fundraise for both jointly. Qualifications will be at Ten Thousand Books discretion.
- 2) Fundraising efforts must reach \$3,000 in order for books to be purchased. This will pay for 100 books for each school that will be cataloged and ready for use in school libraries.
- 3) Any amount raised over \$3,000 shall be submitted to the general fund of Ten Thousand Books.
- 4) If \$3,000 is not reached and the individual decides to abandon fundraising efforts, the amount raised by the individual shall be submitted to the general fund of Ten Thousand Books.
- 5) Books purchased shall be chosen by Ten Thousand Books. Previous purchased books can be viewed on our website at www.tenthousandbooks.org .
